To provide a safe (physically, spiritually, socially) and fun environment where students can experience belonging, learn about Jesus, and be mentored.

Time Expectations

Hours: 6/week Breakdown of time:

- Weekly group interaction (home group, etc) 2 hours
- People time (meet with students) 1 hour
- Sunday morning ministry 1 hour
- Ministry prep/discipleship time 2 hours
- We recognize that with limited time you may want or need to expand your hours on a volunteer basis. We expect that you will recognize your own limitations and not overextend yourself.

Work Expectations

- **Personal Growth and Professional Development -** We cannot give what we do not have; the first expectation of a ministry leader at Pullman Foursquare is that they take the initiative in their own personal growth and development as a follower of Jesus.
- Disciple Students Fun is good; discipleship is the point. The high school youth director will
 determine the best methods to challenge our students towards growth in Jesus and connection
 to community.
- **Sunday Morning Ministry** The high school youth director is expected to participate in the life of the church by being present on Sunday mornings to connect with youth, parents, and guests at least 3 out of 4 Sundays a month. To honor this commitment, we are including one hour of your pay as Sunday morning ministry time.
- Quarterly Fun Event The high school youth director will plan and participate in a quarterly fun event specifically for high school students OR in conjunction with the middle school ministry.
- Camps and Conferences The high school youth director will support, promote, and help transport youth to pivotal spiritual events like camps and conferences, and recruit appropriate parents or youth staff to attend with them as spiritual guides.
- **Communication and Camaraderie -** We have a close-knit staff environment at Pullman Foursquare. We are committed to believing the best of one another and working through our disagreements and difficulties while remaining connected.
- Staff Meetings The high school youth director will attend a quarterly staff meeting for personal/spiritual development and discipleship, and to review and help plan the overall ministry of the church. Additionally, it is hoped that the high school youth director will attend staff retreats, training days, and planning days as scheduled.
